Zeisset family moved from Menzingen about 1851, including the family in the photo and Jakob's parents, Johannes and Christina. No other Mennonite names are found here. They may have lived at Helmtsheim, north of Sindolsheim. Tenant farmers. Johannes (1855) and Jakob (1861) both died here and were buried at Sindolsheim.

Isaak married Bertha Hettinger from nearby Eberstadt in 1863 and first daughter was born in 1863 at Sindolsheim. They also lived a time at Rosshof, just west of Eberstadt.

Jakob Friedrich married Margaretha Müller at Adelsheim in 1864, then moved to Kreuzfeld.

Johannes living near Feuchtwangen, married Elisabetha Bär in 1869 at Berwangen, then lived for awhile at Feuchtwangen in Bavaria.

Magdalena was married the first and second times at Schrozberg in 1873.

Christina Bär Zeisset moved from Sindolsheim to Niedersteinach. Johanna Epp Zeisset probably lived at Schrozberg after leaving Sindolsheim. Daniel may have died at Sindolsheim.
