

Louise Zeisset and John Swart Timeline



- 1860: **John Swart born** in Mark, Germany
- 1866: **Johanna Luise Zeisset born** in Kreuzfeld, Germany
- 1872: Swart family immigrates to Kansas
- 1880: Louise is confirmed at Krailshausen, Germany
- 1881: Louise's mother dies at Kreuzfeld
- 1883: April - Louise immigrates to Pennsylvania and works as a domestic
- 1884: Louise's father dies in Schwäbisch Hall
- 1886: Louise moves to Clay Center, Kansas where she works
- 1887: February - Louise marries John Swart
 - Rent farm from John's parents 4 miles north of Leonardville
 - August - Martha is born
 - John's parents, Marten and Addina, move into Leonardville
- 1888: George is born
- 1889: John's father, Marten, dies in Leonardville
- 1890: Henry is born
- 1891: Lillie Swart is born
- 1893: Betty Swart is born
- 1895: Emma Swart is born
- 1895: October - Swart farm is sold to Peter Skow
- 1896: March - Louise and John Swart move their family to Adams Twp.,
Nemaha County
- 1899: John's mother, Addina, dies in Leonardville
 - John Jr. is born
- 1901: Rosa is born and dies same year

1907: Emma dies
1910: Lillie marries Thomas Johnstone
1913: George marries Zula Gilkerson
1914: Martha marries Max Krummel, moves to Cloud County, Kansas
Henry marries Mary Hailey
1916: Betty marries Horace Duncan
1919: John marries Marjorie Chadwick
1928: Buys citrus farm in Texas
1940: John Swart, Sr. dies; buried at Oneida
1945: Louise dies in car accident in Dallas, Texas; buried at Oneida
