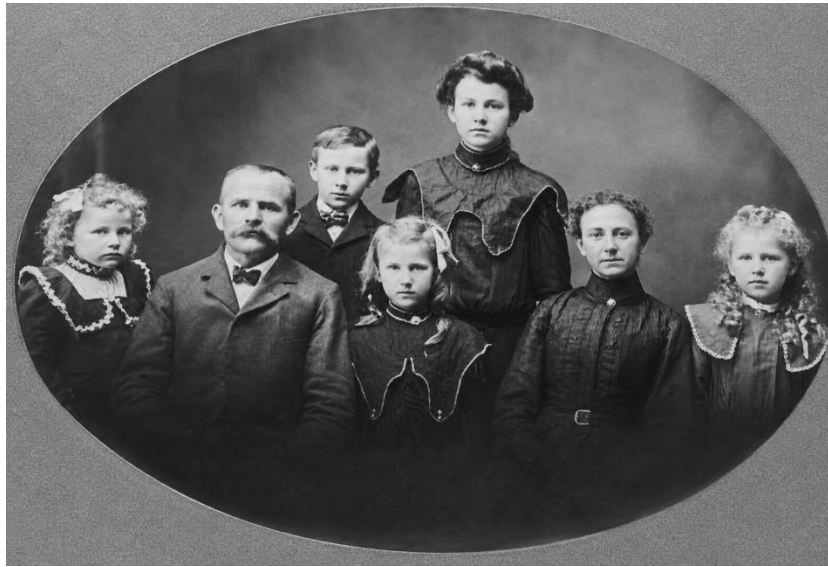


Lizzie Zeisset and George Weller Timeline



- 1864: **Georg Narigat Weller** is born at Onolzheim, Germany to Catharina Narigat and Johann Georg Weller
- 1870: **Lizzie Zeisset** is born and baptized at Kreuzfeld
- 1878: George is confirmed at Onolzheim; goes to work for Isaak Zeisset at Eichenau sometime after that
- 1881: Lizzie's mother dies
- 1883: Lizzie goes to live with Uncle Isaak Zeisset at Eichenau
- 1884: April - Lizzie is confirmed at Lendsiedel
October - Lizzie's father dies
- 1888: Lizzie and George both move to Darstadt with Isaak Zeisset and his family
- 1891: April - Lizzie immigrates to Kansas
July - George immigrates to Kansas
October - Lizzie and George are married at Leonardville; live 1 mile east and 1 mile north of Riley (map 1)
December - Bertha is born
- 1893: Lucy is born in January and dies in March
- 1894: George, Jr. is born
- 1896: Louise is born
- 1899: Minnie is born
- 1901: Lillian is born
- 1906: Carl is born
- 1914: about 1914 - Rented Christian Hoch farm two miles south of Leonardville (map 2)

1915: Bertha marries Oliver Nelson

Wellers live in the Fairview district, near Henry Zeisset

1917: Rented the Fosha farm 2 miles east of Leonardville (map 3)

1920: Louise marries Alva Morris

1925: Lillian marries Gus Carlson

1926: Minnie marries John Uhlenhop

1927: George, Jr. marries Marie Nelson

George Sr.'s father dies in Germany

1928: George Sr.'s mother, Catharina Narigat Mack, dies in Germany

1937: Lizzie and George celebrate 50th wedding anniversary

Lizzie, George, and Carl move to farm one mile north of Riley on Highway 24 (map 4)

1938: November - Lizzie dies of stomach cancer at Riley

1939: Carl marries Una Coutermarsh

1940: George lives with son, George, at Stockdale

1948: George moves to Wamego Nursing Home

1957: George moves to Manhattan nursing home, where he dies

Family Statistics 2026:

Generation One: 7 children; one died in infancy
